

# KEEP YOUR DEBIT/CREDIT CARDS SAFE THIS VACATION SEASON



- ◆ Visually inspect the ATM for possible skimming devices. Potential indicators can include sticky residue or evidence of an adhesive used by criminals to affix the device, scratches, damaged or crooked pieces, loose or extra attachments on the card slot, or noticeable resistance when pressing the keypad.



- \* Call your credit union (and all other banks and card providers you may have) to notify them of your travel plans so they can note it on your account. Make sure to give 48-72 hours advance notice.



- \* Be prepared to provide the state(s) or countries you will be visiting and the date you plan to leave and return.

- \* In the event one of your cards is blocked or if you suspect card fraud, have a list of contact numbers to call immediately to request your card be disabled so no further transactions will be authorized.



- \* Sign up for alerts before you leave so you can receive account information and reminders on the go. Sign up at [Centralsoyafcu.org](http://Centralsoyafcu.org) click on the red *debit card alert* tab.
